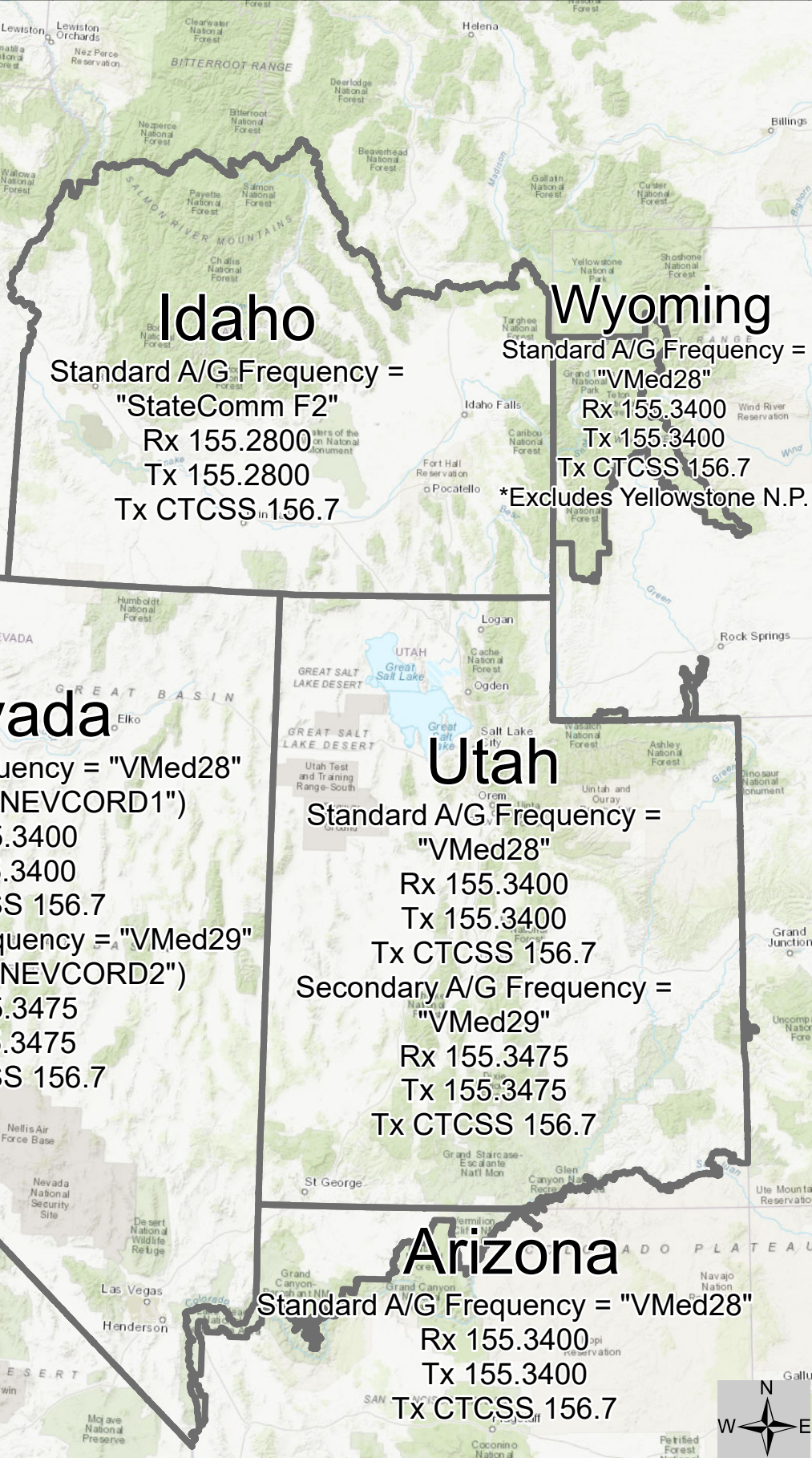


2024 Great Basin Standard Air to Ground Frequencies for Air Ambulance/Air MedEvac on Wildland Fire Incidents
