Erratic and gusty winds to 45 mph possible with any shower or storm. Keep in mind austy winds are possible far away from the nearest precipitation.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Cooler temperatures are in store for today with min RHs reaching the mid-20s. Winds will be southeasterly for most areas, though sheltered locations will still see upslope/upvalley winds. There will be a chance for an isolated shower/thunderstorm today across all the fires. Isolated shower chances will continue through the overnight hours. Any shower/storm can produce erratic and gusty winds to 45 mph. Better RH recoveries (45-55%) are expected tonight with a partly cloudy sky.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE DIVIDE COMPLEX & AMERICAN FORK:

WEATHER: Cooler and less dry conditions are expected today with a partly cloudy sky, 30% chance of a shower/storm. Generally less than 0.05" of rainfall is expected. Erratic wind gusts to 45 mph possible with any shower/storm.

TEMPERATURES:

70-74 ridges and 75-79 valley bottoms

HUMIDITY:

Minimums 26 to 30%

20 FT WINDS:

RIDGETOP - SE at 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph.

SLOPE/VALLEY - SE at 8 to 12 mph with gusts to 20 mph for unsheltered locations. Upslope/upvalley at 5 to 10 mph for sheltered areas.

HAINES INDEX:

3 (Very low chance of plume dominated activity)

CHANCE OF WETTING RAIN (> .10):

STABILITY/INVERSION: Weak inversion breaking by 1000.

OUTLOOK FOR TONIGHT:

A slight chance of a shower with gusty winds will exist through tonight. RH recoveries will be much better with recoveries reaching 45-55%. Skies will be mostly cloudy early becoming partly cloudy. Temperatures will fall to the mid and upper 50s for most areas and the mid and upper 40s for the valley locations.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY AND FRIDAY:

Partly cloudy skies are expected for Thursday with highs mostly in the low and mid 70s. A better chance for an afternoon thunderstorm will exist Thursday with lighter upslope/upvalley winds. Similar temperatures are expected Friday with perhaps a little more sunshine and only a 20% chance of a shower or storm. Winds will turn NE on Friday at 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph. Minimum humidity on Thursday will be around 35 percent and around 30 percent on Friday.

FUEL ASSUMPTIONS: The major fuel types found on the American Fork/Divide Complex are Fuel Model 10 (mixed conifer with heavy dead/down) and Fuel Model 2 (short grass w/timber) in the lower elevations.

Current fuel conditions are favorable for extreme fire behavior within all fuel types, especially 100 hour and 1000 hour fuels. Live fuel moistures are low and will contribute to fire spread. Grass fuels are becoming more available as well. Heavy dead and down will likely be the most problematic. ERC's are approaching all time high's for today's date.

WEATHER SUMMARY: Reference fire weather forecast for specifics.

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Cooler temperatures are in store for today with min RHs reaching the mid-20s. Winds will be southeasterly for most areas, though sheltered locations will still see upslope/upvalley winds. There will be a chance for an isolated shower/thunderstorm today across all the fires.

General Fire Behavior Forecast: General movement will be upslope or towards the north and west today. Current fuel conditions encourage extreme fire behavior. Fuel driven fire with uphill runs and torching or crowning should be expected. Long distance spotting is probable anywhere wind and slope align. Expect a high resistance to control. Expect activity to begin early in the day and to persist thru early evening and into the night hours.

Specific:

American Fork Fire - Westward push into Shields River drainage will continue today. Expect progression to continue unabated until fire reaches rocks/grass. Blacktail fire scar should continue to limit spread to the north. East side should be manageable once fire reaches grass fuels.

Balsinger Fire – Expect fire to continue to progress unabated to the north and west until it runs out of fuel. Fire behavior could be intense, with group torching, crown runs, and long range spotting likely. It will be difficult to suppress fire in conifer fuel under the extremely dry conditions.

Ellis Fire – Smoldering and isolated single tree torching will most likely continue. Any heat source in direct contact with unburned fuel could produce intense fire behavior.

Night Shift – Expect fire to remain active well into the overnight hours – possibly midnight or later. Unexpectedly intense fire behavior is possible. Forward movement of fire with torching or short canopy runs cannot be ruled out.

Trigger Points: Establish a wind threshold for your crew to disengage from the fire line.




