Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: This fire was VERY active tonight growing by 61% in the past 24 hours. I began mapping from the previous IR perimeter. The biggest growth area was in the southern and southeastern flanks where the fire grew up to three miles in some areas. There was abundant intense heat in the expansion zones and scattered heat throughout most of the remainder of the interior.
