Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: I began mapping from the previous fire perimeter in NIFS. There was only minor fire expansion. One portion of the north flank in Section 3 grew less than 0.25 miles downslope. There was no intense heat and limited interior scattered heat mostly in the southern half of the fire as well as the northern flank expansion zone.
