Div. M – Areas of concern are Dugout Creek and Lodgepole Creek.

Div. P - Watch for fire movement and runs in the Shields River drainage, around the Crandell Creek.

Woods Creek

Div. YY - The Atlantic Creek and Boulder Creek drainages are of concern.

Div. MM – Watch for the potential of fire moving in the Gypsy Creek drainage. There is still a large concentration of heat in this area.

AIR OPERATIONS:

SAFETY MESSAGE

Divide Complex Friday August 6 2021

Complacency, Dehydration, Safe Driving, Steep terrain and hazard trees, and communications

COMPLACENCY--- It's been a long fire season, resources are stretched thin yet there is more work to do. We cannot afford to drop our guard. Stay alert!! Accidents occur when we start taking things for granted. Many of the same safety hazards are still there. Watch for fatigue and stay focused on tasks at hand.

STEEP TERRAIN/HAZARD TREES --- Steep slopes with fire weakened trees remains a concern. "Look up, look down, and look around." Post lookouts when needed. Watch footing not only on the ground, but also when getting on and off equipment.

SAFE DRIVING --- Focus on driving! Don't allow yourself to become distracted. Slow down and pay attention both on the fire and in town. Make sure drivers are alert and ok to operate the vehicle. Watch out for wildlife especially around dawn and dusk. Take it slow around blind curves and narrow roads. Drive with your lights on.

DEHYDRATION --- Stay hydrated, even with cooler and wetter weather predicted, we need to continue to stay hydrated. Be sure to drink plenty of water throughout the day and mix with sports liquids fortified with potassium.

COMMUNICATIONS --- There are a few communication dead zones on this fire. Identify and mitigate those situations by using human repeaters or other methods, i.e. using booster antennas. Stay in communications with your supervisors on changes in weather and fire behavior. Rule of thumb -"If you see something, say something."

- Please remember to take at least a 30-minute break every 8-hours. If a break is not taken, please document in remarks section on the bottom the CTR reason why break was not taken.
- Contact Finance Section via email 2-days prior to your scheduled **demob** date.
- ADs please make sure you have sent in your Casual Hire and Resource Order to the email address that reflects the fire listed on your Resource Order.

Finance Remote Processing Procedures

To the right is access to electronic Finance forms. You can access them via the QR code or the URL. On each form are four buttons PRINT, RESET, SAVE and EMAIL. You can complete these forms on your cell phone, tablet or laptop. They are Adobe PDF forms so you will need a PDF reader app on your device. The forms were created on a laptop so the commands in your cell phone and tablet do not allow for the Save and Print functions to work. You will need to use your app's functionality to Save or Print.





- 5. For water handling equipment that has drafted from streams, lakes or ponds, you must decontaminate your fittings and drafting hose (footvalve, hose, etc) at the Aquatic Invasive Species Decontamination station co-located with the weed wash. Follow directions on the tank.
- 6. Go to the Time Unit to complete time and review their final OF-288 or OF-286. This may be done virtually if necessary.
- 7. Report back to the Demobilization Unit to verify travel information home, including ETD/ETA and RON locations. This can be done virtually if necessary.
