Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping utilized the previous night's IR as a base. Perimeter growth along with intense heat was mapped in the fire's southeastern and northeastern corners. One disconnected polygon of intense heat was mapped east of the main fire and southeast of Gipsy Lake. This heat polygon is on both sides of FS trail 150. Intense heat was also mapped north of Camas Ridge on the steep north facing slopes of the Atlanta Creek drainage. Large pockets of scattered heat remain throughout the fire area, as do isolated heat sources.
