Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping used the wildfire daily perimeter as a starting point. Growth was limited, on the fire again tonight, with some westward expansion and intense heat mapped on the fire's western edge north of Trough Creek. A few small areas of growth associated with intense heat were also mapped on the eastern half of the fire northwest of Signal Rock. No growth was mapped on the eastern most edge of the fire. Interior heat sources were primarily isolated heat with some small pockets of scattered heat.
