Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping used the previous shift's IR heat perimeter as a base. Limited growth was mapped tonight. Growth occurred on the fire's western edge south of Hog Trough Creek. A polygon of intense heat was also mapped along the fire's northern edge along with some perimeter growth where the 77 trail crosses the ridgeline. No growth was mapped along the fire's eastern edge. Isolated heat sources were mapped throughout the fire's interior.
