Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping used the previous shift's IR heat perimeter as a base. Three acres of growth were mapped tonight in the fire's northwestern corner north of Hog Trough Creek. This area of perimeter growth was associated with a small pocket of intense heat. Scattered heat was noted along the fire's southwestern edge. Isolated heat sources were once again mapped in the fire's interior. No growth to the east was mapped this shift.
