Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping used the NIFS wildfire daily perimeter as a base for interpretation. Perimeter growth and intense heat were mapped in the fire's northwestern corner north of Hog Trough Creek and south of FS trail 77. Growth was also mapped in the area of Signal Rock, where the previous night's two lobes of fire have now become one. One 1/3 acre spot fire was mapped on the eastern facing slopes of Signal Rock just east of the main fire.
