Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Mapping used the incident perimeters as a base for mapping, pulled from NIFS on 8/24/23 @ 0309 MDT. Mapped perimeter change was limited to 48 acres with most of the growth showing on the fire's northern edge between Sage Creek Saddle and Chilco Saddle. No areas of intense heat were mapped. Scattered heat along the fire's perimeter was mapped along the fire's northern and northeastern edge in Div K and Div E. Isolated heat sources were mapped throughout much of the fire area.
