Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located on Jay Point, 0.75 miles south of U.S. Highway 12 and the Lochsa River, between river mile 66 and 67. It is bounded by Robin Creek to the west and Jay Creek to the east. Perimeter has burned over the Jay Point electronic site and lookout. Intense heat on the northeast and southwest perimeters. Three hot spots outside the heat perimeter to the east, one is across Jay Creek.
