Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Fire is located approximately 0.5 mile southeast of Scurvy Mountain Lookout on ridge south of Scurvy Lake and north of Never Creek. There are no isolated heat sources outside of the perimeter. Intense heat on the northeast, southeast and west of the heat perimeter.
