Perimeter is essentially unchanged from 9/2. Isolated heat sources were detected inside the perimeter north and south of Swamp Creek, east of Kooskooskia Meadows and along Cedar Ridge at the southern end of the fire. There was one potential heat source outside the perimeter which is labeled on the map.
