Also some fire growth in section 34 & 25 on the northwest side of fire. Growth in section 32 just east of Goat Heaven Peaks.</p> <p>New fire poly in section 4 on east side of fire and fire growth in Section 3 on south east side of fire. Fire polygon that is outside of main fire perimeter on the south side of the fire had considerable growth down into section 7.</p>
