<b>Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> Fire is located on the Deer Lodge National Forest, 1 mile west of the Butte and Jefferson County line, 1.5 miles east of Interstate Highway 15, and ½ mile north of Baker's Meadow on Nez Perce Creek. Interpretation started with incident's perimeter from 09/01 (687 acres). Increase in acres due to perimeter adjustments to include adjacent isolated heat sources. There were 3 isolated heat sources detected outside of the perimeter to the east. These are labeled on the map.
