Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Increase in acres due to perimeter adjustments to include adjacent isolated heat sources. There were no isolated heat sources outside of the perimeter. Intense heat approximately ½ mile north of the Gallatin River on the western perimeter.
