## Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

None of the "Potential Heat Sources" mapped on the previous shift showed any heat signatures tonight.

Perimeter growth continues to occur along the southwestern corner, southern edge and to the east with areas of perimeter expansion showing intense heat. Between Yukon Creek and Klondike Creek, the fire has reached and in places crossed FS road 4160c. On the east side, multiple spot fires were mapped between point 8123 and Stonewall Creek.

Very little perimeter growth was detected on the northern side of the fire.

The easternmost portions of the Arrastra Creek fire are now approximately 1.5 miles west of the Park Creek fire.

The Park Creek Incident was scanned at the same time as Arrastra Creek, and those products can be downloaded from the Park Creek folder on the NIFC FTP.
