Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Utilized 20170725_IR perimeter for interpretation. Intense heat detected on ridge between Corona and Sequoia Gulches, the ridge north of Brewster Creek, and in several hot spots located on the south flank of Golden Mountain. There are several hot spots near Slide Rock Lookout, 2.4 miles SE of the fire. These are not shown on map but points are in Isolated Heat shapefile.
