The scan box to the NE had no heat visible and pilots confirmed. There was no scan of Lone Pine Point or Mink Peak. Fire is bounded by Clearwater river to SW and Moose Creek to the west. Intense heat detected in Hell Creek and north of the Moose Creek Airstrip.
