Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Started interpretation with 20170904 @ 0220 perimeter. Growth since last IR along entire perimeter. Pockets of intense heat along the northern, southern, and eastern perimeter. Isolated heat sources were detected outside the perimeter. One is approximately 2 miles southeast at Warm Springs Bar on Running Creek. The others were at the very edge of the imagery. They are 4 to 5 miles east of the perimeter atop Running Peak and on the north flank of Mount Aura. These are not shown on the map but are in the isolated heat source shapefile.
