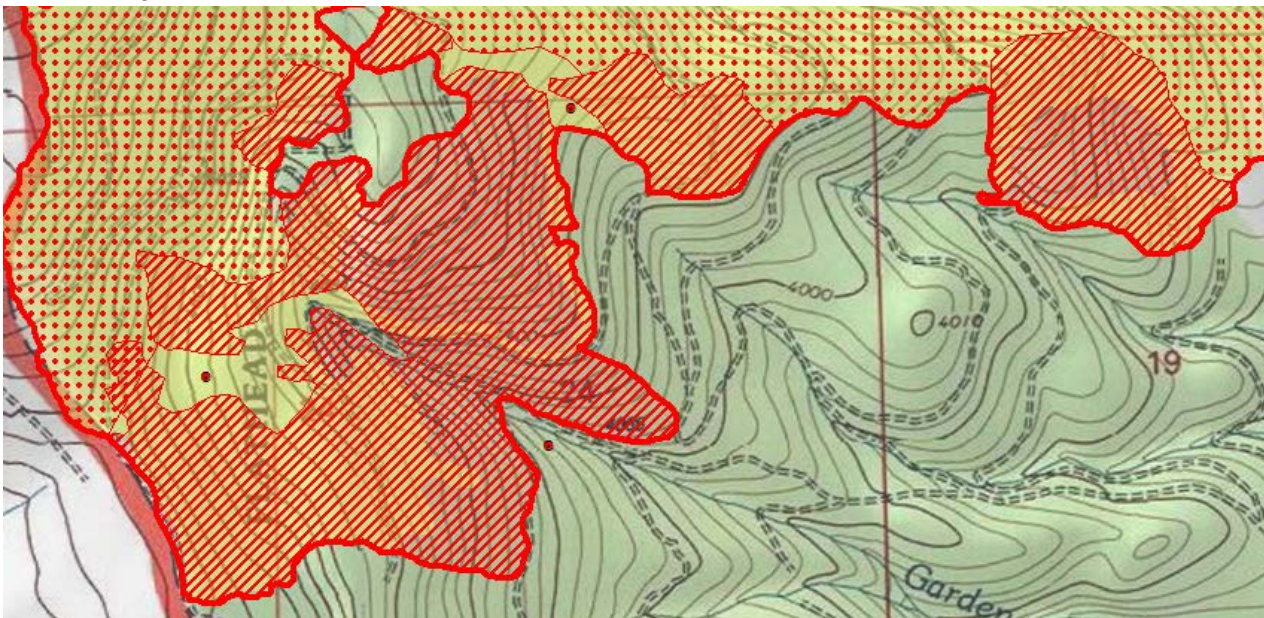

Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I started my interpretation with the 08/08/2018 IR fire perimeter. New growth - 176 acres.

Yellow is 8/08/2018's IR perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter.

Southeast growth: Fire growth was to the southeast. There is intense heat as well as scattered heat in this area. The holes from last night have now closed.
