Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Interpretation started with 8/22 IR perimeter.

Fire still remains most active on west flank moving down the north side of the Kenney Creek drainage. Vast majority of interior, northern and eastern flanks are cooling with mostly isolated heats. Most scattered heat is widely scattered.
