<b>Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b>  For interpreting tonight, I received a perimeter from the incident: <a href="#">/incident_specific_data/n_rookies/2018_fires/2018_PaolaRidge/Data/20180815/20180815_2200_PaolaRidge_MTFNF374_Event_ArcMap10_5.gdb.zip</a>  New spot fire perimeter away from the main fire, to the east, downslope.  Intense heat noted in the eastern side of the perimeter, and in the perimeter downslope to the east of the main perimeter.  Scattered heat throughout much of the rest of the interior, except in places where it appears the heat has cooled.
