Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

I started my interpretation from infra-red heat perimeter dated 08/23/2018 with a starting acreage of 598. New heat perimeter is 645 acres – Growth of 47 acres.

In the follow maps - Yellow is 8/23/2018's IR heat perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter.

Most of the activity of the fire is on the eastern half of the fire with just a few isolated heat sources on the western half of the fire. There were 3 isolated heat sources outside the main heat perimeter.
