Started interpreting tonight using the IR perimeter delivered on 8/9.

Areas of intense heat at the south western part of the fire, including some areas of heat away from the main fire perimeter up to the unnamed peak.

Areas of scattered heat throughout some of the western half of the perimeter, not much heat at all in the eastern half of the perimeter.
