Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Started interpreting tonight using the IR perimeter delivered on 8/10.

Perimeter growth and intense heat noted in the Lockwood Creek drainage. Some intense heat and perimeter growth at the unnamed peak east of Lockwood Point.

A few place with intense heat noted at the south western most part of the fire, north of Lockwood creek. These places are interior and not associated with perimeter growth.

Scattered heat noted through most of the south western half of the fire, not much heat and just a few isolated heat sources along the eastern half of the fire.
