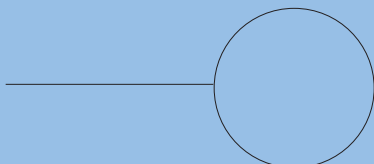


## DISPLAY IN VEHICLE



### National Forest Recreation Pass

Honored at day-use sites in Oregon and Washington where “Recreation Pass Required” signs are posted.



A list of recreation sites where fees are required is available online and from Forest Service offices in Oregon and Washington.

Revenues from pass sales go toward maintaining and improving Forest Service facilities and trails in Oregon and Washington.

The pass does not cover fees for opportunities such as:

- Sno-Parks (winter season)
- Some concessionaire operated sites
- Developed campgrounds
- Cabin rentals
- Wilderness, climbing, and river permits
