



Before you go....

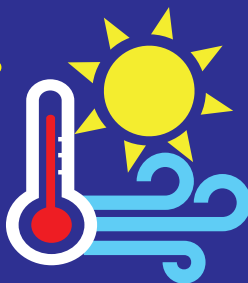


Get a map.

Know where you can camp on public lands, and check for any restrictions.

Check the weather.

Avoid campfires on hot, dry and windy days. Watch fire danger ratings and red flag warnings.



Be ready to put out a fire.



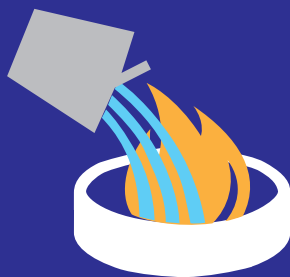
Pack a fire extinguisher, water and a shovel. You may be responsible for the cost of fire suppression if you start a wildfire.

While you are here...



Make sure your fire is dead out.

If fires are allowed, drown, stir and drown again, then check for warmth.

Do not park or drive on dry grass.

Hot exhaust systems could ignite dry grass, so park only in designated areas, or in areas free of flammable materials.



Obey restrictions.

Explosives, including fireworks and exploding targets, are prohibited on public lands.



Sky lanterns are prohibited.

Sky lanterns are illegal to release into Oregon airspace.



Call 911 to report a wildfire.
