Our forests are home to the matsutake, prized all over the world for its unique taste. Due to fire danger, you must take extreme care to avoid starting a wildfire while in the forest.

NO FIRES Due to Wildfire Danger

All open fires are prohibited on the Deschutes National Forest. There are no exceptions for developed or hosted campgrounds.

PERMITTED









You can smoke in an enclosed vehicle or building, in a designated campground, in boats on lakes and rivers, or while stopped in an area at least 3 feet in diameter that is clear of all flammable material.

PROHIBITED

- Smoking
 - Campfires
 - Warming fires
 - Cooking fires
- Portable propane campfires
- Charcoal fires
- Biomass or particle woodburning stoves
 - Wood pellet grills or smokers.
