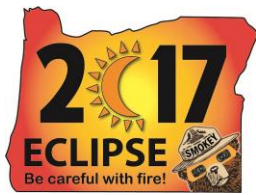


Central Oregon Eclipse Prevention Education Team Daily Report

- ✚ The safety message for August 11, 2017, was to maintain flexibility to reduce injury. A diagram of helpful stretches was provided.
- ✚ Continued to sift out issues with Google Drive as they arose throughout the day. The team's fiscal spreadsheet was completed to-date and forwarded on to Karen and Lauren. The team's job Hazard Analysis was completed and signed by all team members and handed off to overhead for approval and to be signed off.
- ✚ A contact card was created for the information boards should the board be damaged or moved. A large calendar was created and printed with important dates for display in the team's work space.
- ✚ A spreadsheet for documenting field accomplishments was constructed and added to the team's Google drive for documenting daily accomplishments.
