- ✚ Team assisted the Ochoco NF and BLM Offices in setting up a major Prineville Information booth along Hwy 26. A second booth was then organized and implemented at Ray's Grocery store.
- ✚ Team designed and constructed an international board where visitors could mark their home locations on a world map, as well as, place comments in a guest book.
- ✚ Eclipse-Prevention cooperative materials were distributed to the Redmond Air Base, Oregon Dept. of Forestry and BLM Office, Prineville.
- ✚ Position Task Books were reviewed and PETM-T accomplishments documented to date.
- ✚ Northern Ochoco trap-line was traveled hanging 2 new 4X4' signs, posting one A-frame info. board, making 6 public contacts, 2 business contacts and covering 300 miles.
- ✚ The Park Service Headquarters of Fossil Beds National Monument were visited and enthusiastically accepted a wide variety of COFMS materials for distribution.
- ✚ Our Team PIOF Meg Cicciarella worked a full and busy day at the Ray's Info. Booth.
- ✚ Directional signs used for guiding the public to Information activities were shared from the NE FPET, created and laminated for central OR posting.
- ✚ Participated in the NW FPET conference call.
- ✚ A southern trapline was traveled later in the day which included 3 Districts, covering 210 miles, 15 businesses, 1 partner and 7 public contacts.
- ✚ Communications were established with Public Information on the High Cascades complex for coordinated support of their outreach to the Oregon Jamboree scheduled for 8/19 in Prospect, OR. The CO FPET will organize and supply the needed prevention-eclipse materials.
- ✚ Two Team members coordinated personal logistics, as they prepared to relocate to Cascade and Sisters districts, in support of their local welcome-education efforts starting 8/17 0800.
