Team Accomplishment August 16-17th:

Overview:

Today we continued working our expanded “trap-lines,” and building capacity for the Eclipse event by increasing our supply of materials for strategic placement, and meeting partners and agency representative for material distribution. Checking in and out, along with driving safety are top priorities.



Product Delivery, Coordination and Relationship Building:

- **North Santiam:**
 - **Molalla River Recreation Corridor, BLM – August 16th**
 - Placed a total of **14 signs** at the following locations:
 - ✓ Road Entrance
 - ✓ Sandquist Trailhead
 - ✓ Hardy Trailhead
 - ✓ Swimming Hole - Day Use

- ✓ Along Roadway
- ✓ Table Rock Trailhead, Wilderness Kiosk and Day Use site.
- ✓ Dispersed Use Sites
- ✓ 3 Bears Recreation Site along Road

- Notes:
 - ✓ We asked a visitor at one dispersed site to extinguish their campfire and gave them information about the fire regulations.
 - ✓ We also contacted several visitors and gave out stickers and coins to kids.

- **Breitenbush Rd, Blowout Rd and Detroit, Willamette NF – August 17th**
 - Placed **19 signs** at the following locations along the Breitenbush and Blowout roads:
 - ✓ Fox Creek Group Site
 - ✓ Humbug Campground
 - ✓ Upper Arm Day Use Site
 - ✓ Entrance to Breitenbush road
 - ✓ Blowout road entrance
 - ✓ Santiam Flats Campground

 - Distributed Stickers, Coins, Table toppers and Placemats at the following locations around the city of Detroit:
 - ✓ Detroit Market
 - ✓ Corner Post Restaurant
 - ✓ The Cedars Restaurant
 - ✓ Conners Barbeque
 - ✓ Deli/Gas Station

 - Note:
 - ✓ Attended the Detroit Ranger District all-employee meeting and Eclipse Incident Action Plan meeting. We strategized deployment of Fire Prevention and Education materials with the District Eclipse Patrols.
 - ✓ Attended and handed out stickers and coins along with “Fire Wise” materials at the Whitewater Fire IMT Community Meeting in Detroit held by PNW Team 2.

- **Mary’s Peak:**
 - **Philomath – August 16th**
 - Met with Mike Totey, District Forester and Pat MacMeekin Community Wildfire Forester of the ODF Philomath District Office. We discussed areas that would be a good location for posting fire restriction signs. We left prevention material with them to post and hand out.

 - Note: We posted fire restriction signs at the post office and several businesses in Philomath.

 - **Philomath, Alsea, Walport, Newport and Dallas – August 17th**
 - Met with Allison Blair, ODF Protection Supervisor in Philomath. She suggested several campgrounds where she would like us to post signs. We provided additional prevention products to that unit.
 - Areas where the team posted prevention signs and/or left prevention materials to be given to the public:

- ✓ Alsea Post Office
 - ✓ BLM Alsea River Area including the Alsea Falls Day Use and Campgrounds to notify the public of a new fire closure order.
 - ✓ Missouri Bend Campground
 - ✓ Blackberry Campground
 - ✓ Several grocery stores, restaurants and other businesses in Waldport
 - ✓ Alsea Bay Historic Interpretative Center
 - ✓ Oregon Coast Aquarium
 - ✓ Center Market in Dallas
 - ✓ The team met Pam Dalton owner of a private campground in Dallas and provided her with materials to hand out to her campers.
 - ✓ The team is working with Jill Peters, Eclipse Event Manager for OSU to set up a table on campus with prevention materials.
- **Quartzville Corridor:**
 - **Lebanon and Sweet Home area – August 17th**
 - Met with Sweet Home Ranger District Staff and volunteers to finalize the upcoming weekend and Eclipse plans, distributed fire prevention materials, and loaded supplies provided by the Sweet Home Ranger District.
 - ✓ Completed trap line in Lebanon – posted signs, delivered rack cards and table tents.
 - ✓ Started trap line in Sweet Home.
 - ✓ Delivered two banners to ODF Sweet Home office: one is displayed at the entrance to Brownsville Music Festival; and one on Highway 20 at Foster Lake Day Use Site.
 - ✓ Visited campgrounds along Highway 20; posted signs, made public contacts and distributed “NoFire” information.
