Avenza Pro Users,

The 2021 maps are available for download into Avenza Maps. I'm trying to make it easier to download multiple maps instead of having to downloading 1 map at a time. Each of the files (with the .avenzamaps file extension) attached to this email contain one of these map series:

- Green Dot Maps
- Fire Atlas Maps (FFPA information is included this year orange crosshatched areas are paying FFPA)
- DNR "100k quad-like" maps (one file covers Eastern WA & one file for Western WA)
- USFS OWF Maps from 2020

To download the maps to Avenza using these .avenzamaps files, use these links to find instructions for your <u>Apple Device</u> or <u>Android Device</u>.

Here are some helpful hints for successfully downloading the .avenzamaps files:

- You must have a licensed copy of Avenza Maps Pro
- Make sure you have your device plugged into to a power source (the download will drain your battery)
- If your cell coverage isn't good (or if you have a Wi-Fi only tablet) make sure to connect to Wi-Fi
- Only download one map series at a time
- Before you import the files, open the Avenza App and go to the main "Maps" screen. As you download, a folder will be created with your new map (ie "Fire Atlas 2021") and the maps will download into that file. As the download starts, open the newly created folder and monitor the download. You may need to tap the map if the download doesn't start automatically. If you get a message saying it can't download the map, make sure you have a good cell or Wi-Fi connection and keep trying... it will work eventually!

If you prefer to download one map at a time, the maps are still available on Box and can be accessed using the "Avenza Map Links 2021.pdf" file attached to this email.
