Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Started interpretation using the perimeter found in the event polygon on the NIFS (pulled 06/26/2024 0015 PDT) No intense or scattered heat found associated with the 1980 Slide Ranch Fire. Fourteen isolated heat sources found along the Toppenish Creek within the fire perimeter. A small section of the southwest fire not included in the imagery.
