<b>Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> The Bailey Butte Fire grew acres to approximately 8,416 acres. While the fire is still hot on the east and south sides the extreme heat at the advancing fire head is not present tonight. There are numerous spotfires outside of the primary heat perimeter. The northern portion and center of the fire area is cooling with a few isolated heat sources.  The Chuckwagon Spring Fire (OCF-325) was also included in scan #1 and is approximately 128 acres.
