<b>Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> Ten heat sources were detected outside of the perimeter and are identified on the map. Increase in fire perimeter since last flight is primarily to the southwest. Very slight changes in the heat perimeter elsewhere. There are two areas that show possible heat in a recent clearcut approximately 1,500' outside of the southwest heat perimeter. These are also identified on the map.
