| Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Perimeter has essentially not changed since the last flight. No isolated heat sources detected outside of the heat perimeter. Incident straddles the Baker-Malheur County line and both sides of U.S. Highway 26 from the Unity State Forest Wayside, across Eldorado Pass, to 1.5 miles west of Middle Willow Creek crossing. Heat perimeter has reached Lake Gulch to the north, Long and King Creeks to the west, North Willow Creek to the east, and Bridge Creek to the south. | | | |
