<b>Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> The heat perimeter grew predominately in the south. There was one new isolated heat source outside the heat perimeter on the east portion of the fire. The Southern side of the fire has the largest concentrations of intense heat. There has been a reduction in the amount of intense heat since the last flight. There are numerous isolated heat sources throughout the heat perimeter. The fire is located south of Milo and the South Umpqua River, east of Coon Creek, north of Diamond Rock, west of Callahan Meadows and 0.8 miles west of both Tiller and Drew. The fire is about 2.8 miles from the Douglas/Jackson county line to the south.
