
Wildfire Public Safety Plan



This map shows the Management Action Points (MAP) for the Cougar Creek Fire. If fire progresses past these lines, evacuation levels will be set for the corresponding zones on the map.

- -Fire line past the GREEN line means Zone "A" is at a Level 1 evacuation(evac).
- -Fire line past the BLACK line means Zone "A" is at Level 2 evac and Zone "B" Level 1 evac.
- -Fire line past the RED line means Zone "A" is at Level 3 evac, Zone "B" is Level 2 evac, and Zone "C" Level 1 evac.
- -Fire line past the BLUE line means Zones "A" and "B" are at Level 3 evac, Zone "C" Level 2 evac, and Zone "D" Level 1 evac.
- -Fire line past the PURPLE line means Zones "A" "B" and "C" are at Level 3 evac and Zone "D" Level 2 evac.

Three levels of evacuation status are established

Level 1 is an advisory notification. Residents should be aware of the danger that exists and monitor local media outlets for information. Residents with special needs, or those with pets or livestock should take note and make preparations. **During this level, an automated call will be sent by Klickitat County Emergency Management to all land lines and 'registered citizens.'**

Level 2 indicates there is significant risk to your area, and residents should voluntarily relocate, either to a shelter or with family/friends outside of the area, or be ready to leave at a moment's notice. During this level, an automated call will be made by Klickitat County Emergency Management to all land lines and 'registered citizens' and emergency personnel will contact residents through door to door visits.

Level 3 means your area is in imminent danger and you should leave immediately. During this level, an automated call will be made by Klickitat County Emergency Management to all land lines and 'registered citizens' and emergency personnel will contact residents through door to door visits.
