Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: There are numerous isolated heat sources throughout the heat perimeter in both the top and middle polygons. The highest concentrations of heat are located on the Northern, Eastern and Western edges of the most northern polygon/portion of the fire. The most southern polygon/portion of the fire was not flown due to it being well south of the scan box. The scan box has been update for the next flight to more accurately capture all three portions of the fire. The fire is located south of Salmon Creek, east of Fogarty Creek State Park, west of the Siletz River and north of the South Depot Bay Creek.
