Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Some growth on north central and west center. Two spots intense on ridge east of Last Chance Creek – top of west facing slope near two-track (section 19)

Lot of growth on south in 3 main areas. Merged with formerly disconnected finger between Barney and Stevens Creek. Very intense in these three fingers. Roughly 1.3 miles to Look from finger on ridge west of Barney Creek.

Small spot south of middle finger between South fork Burnt River and Bear Creek, on FR160 mid-slope (section 7) [44.36863, -118.342938], two others on same slope closer to bottom and north near merging of river/creek (section 6) [44.376345, -118.335777; 44.373987, -118.3379].

Off the west end of the middle south finger there are four spots on north facing slope (section 12 and north), [44.377754, -118.361514; 44.37991, -118.360486; 44.379371, -118.357122; 44.37808, -118.362645]

West growth has spot and possible second (44.403893, -118.413191) off northwest corner along FR2655, (sw edge section 27) ridge top to northwest facing slope.
