LEVEL 1 – A Level 1 Evacuation means “BE READY” for potential evacuation. Residents should be aware of the danger that exists in their area, monitor emergency services websites and local media outlets for information.

HIGH CASCADES COMPLEX – Union Creek Level 1 Trigger: : Evacuation notice issued on August 29, 2017

LEVEL 2 – A Level 2 Evacuation means “BE SET” to evacuate. YOU MUST PREPARE TO LEAVE AT A MOMENTS NOTICE. This level indicates there is significant danger to your area, and residents should either voluntarily relocate to a shelter or with family/friends outside of the affected area, or if choosing to remain, to be ready to evacuate at a moment’s notice.

HIGH CASCADES COMPLEX, Union Creek Level 2 Trigger: Fire becomes established east of USFS Road 6510-700.

LEVEL 3 – A Level 3 Evacuation means “GO” Evacuate NOW LEAVE IMMEDIATELY! Danger to your area is current or imminent, and you should evacuate immediately.

HIGH CASCADES COMPLEX, Union Creek Level 3 Trigger: Fire becomes established between USFS Forest Road 6510 and the Rogue River in the vicinity of Union Creek.
