Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Utilized 20170728@0119 IR perimeter for starting interpretation. Majority of growth since last flight is to the east where the fire has reached the headwaters of Diamond Creek and is approaching Upper and Lower Fox Lakes. Intense heat detected in the east and south perimeter. Scattered heat remains along Diamond Creek in the interior. Multiple heat sources detected outside of the southern perimeter, on the flanks of Nanny Goat Mountain.
