Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Utilized 20170731@1900 IR perimeter provided by incident for starting interpretation. IR consisted of 2 passes. Growth since last IR 20170731@2307 is to the NE where perimeter has reached the base of Diamond Point and Upper and Lower Fox Lakes, to the SW where perimeter is descending to Drake Creek, and to NW along Dollar Creek. Isolated heat sources were detected outside the northern, eastern and southern perimeter. Due to time constraints, not all of the isolated heat sources within the perimeter were mapped, only those adjacent to the perimeter.
