Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: There was a great deal of expansion in the Grave Creek fires with spotting to the south. The Pleasant Creek fire grew in all directions, but is displaying intense heat in a few locations around the fire. The Taylor fire was added this evening and shows signs of cooling The Ditch Creek fire, the Spencer fire, and the King Mountain fire are all showing signs of cooling with scattered heat.
