Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Grave Creek: The biggest expansion is on the southern tip of the fire and activity is quite hot. There is also intense heat above the houses in Grave Creek. The unburned island is getting smaller. Taylor: The largest expansion was on the west side of the fire and there are two spotfires on the south side of the fire 77 acres and 246 acres. There is a 32 acre unburned island in the northwest portion of the fire. Pleasant Creek: Moderate expansion on the north, overall cooling from last night Ditch Creek: Moderate expansion on the west flank (burnout?), new 5 acre fire ½ mile north-east towards the main Grave Creek fire.
