## Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

**Taylor:** Most active behavior and growth on the incident was on the west flank of Taylor. Fire activity was not nearly as intense on the east side of the fire.

**Grave Creek**: Moderate expansion on the east and south flanks of the fire and where the two fires grew together. The largest area of growth was in the Jamison Gulch area

**Pleasant Creek:** Moderate expansion on the north side of the fire, but general overall cooling throughout the fire area.

**Ditch Creek**: The main Ditch Creek fire is showing good cooling, and the spot fire in Section 9 grew on the north side
