Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Taylor: Most active behavior and growth on the incident was on the west flank of Taylor. Fire activity was not nearly as intense on the east side of the fire. Grave Creek: Moderate expansion on the east and south flanks of the fire and where the two fires grew together. The largest area of growth was in the Jamison Gulch area Pleasant Creek: Moderate expansion on the north side of the fire, but general overall cooling throughout the fire area. Ditch Creek: The main Ditch Creek fire is showing good cooling, and the spot fire in Section 9 grew on the north side
