Grave Creek: Several places of expansion and intense heat combined with the Ditch Creek polygon. Pleasant Creek: Pocket of intense heat in the northeast corner, otherwise cooling throughout. Ditch Creek: Combined with the spot fire to the north and the Grave creek fire, some intense heat pockets. Spencer Fire: A few isolated heat sources left.
